

MILESTONES

2016 was a milestone year for Resource Center. We completed construction and opened the new LGBTQ community center on Cedar Springs Road, beautifully renovated our health campus on Reagan Street, saw a record number of people for testing through our prevention programs and Nelson-Tebedo Clinic, and exceeded the goal of our capital campaign.

Attendance and activity increased with the co-location of services and programs in the new community center for youth (Youth First), seniors (Gray Pride), mental health counseling, transgender individuals (G.E.A.R.), and women (Women With Pride). Additionally, we welcomed hundreds of guests who wanted to learn more about the programs in the center as well as the architecture and donated art. Even during the renovation of the health campus at 2701 Reagan Street, the Center provided uninterrupted service in our lunch program and continued to serve more than 2,700 clients living with HIV/AIDS.

In the midst of these accomplishments, we also felt tremendous loss in the wake of the most deadly mass shooting in our

country's history. Forty-nine people, most of whom were LGBTQ and LatinX, were gunned down at Pulse nightclub in Orlando, Florida. At Resource Center and across the United States, LGBTQ community centers served as the places to gather, grieve and heal. And, as the nation grappled with the violent deaths of people of color and law enforcement, the Center worked with dozens of organizations to build bridges among those communities and others.

We are grateful for your support of our mission and programs. I hope you enjoy these stories about the people you impact every day through your investment in our work.

Resource Center provides essential nutritional support to people living with HIV/AIDS with food distributed through the food pantry and weekday hot meals program. A healthy diet improves quality of life and good nutrition helps keep the immune system strong, enabling a person living with HIV to better fight the disease.

"A little over a year ago, I got sick. Every time I swallowed, it was like broken glass, and I eventually dropped to 130 lbs. Unable to maintain my work schedule, I was let go from my job at the end of June 2016. When I finally went to the hospital after a month, the doctor told me I was lucky to be alive. He said I had a severe case of pneumonia and my entire body was racked with infections. He went on to say. . . the cause of all this sickness was I had full-blown AIDS. Without a job or income, that panic and fear of what I was going to do next were as devastating as the diagnosis. Then a kind case worker gave me a brochure for this organization named RESOURCE CENTER. She gently put her hand on mine and reassuringly told me, 'They will help you.'



I will never forget the day I walked through the doors at the Health Campus. After being told the food pantry was closed for the day, the staff member made a quick phone call and then led me through a door where two volunteers escorted me around the pantry and filled a shopping cart full of groceries for me

Today, the nutrition program plays a vital role in maintaining my healthy lifestyle. The food pantry keeps my kitchen stocked with a balanced variety of the right kinds of food, and the hot meals program serves nutritious and delicious meals! All of this has helped me regain weight to a now healthy 175 lbs."

The Center's Advocacy program met with 17 school districts in Dallas County to advocate for LGBTQ-inclusive nondiscrimination and bullying policies



ADVOCACY IN THE COMMUNITY

- Addressed the University Interscholastic League (UIL) in opposition to a ban on transgender athletes competing as the gender with which they identify.
- Continued work on behalf of safety and security in the Oak Lawn area as part of "Take Back Oak Lawn", a group that was recognized by the City of Dallas' LGBTQ Task Force and Stonewall Democrats of Dallas.
- Spoke out on behalf of a gay man fired by the Collin County Sheriff's department who claimed he was terminated because he refused to endure anti-LGBTQ workplace comments from a contract nurse at the jail. The nurse's employer, at the recommendation of the Center, boosted their LGBTQ nondiscrimination policies.
- Conducted over 24 cultural competency presentations including UT Southwestern Medical Center, the UNT College of Pharmacy, Institute for Law Enforcement Administration, Texas Health Resources and UTA Ubuntu Social Justice Conference.

Worked with city 3 Dallas suburbs to advocate and adopt a new city employment nondiscrimination policy that includes sexual orientation and gender identity



ADVOCACY

Advocacy for the LGBTQ and HIV/AIDS communities we serve extends back to the Center's founding in 1983.

Today, advocacy takes many forms, from visiting with state lawmakers about policy and funding issues, to actively working with businesses, school districts, and government agencies to develop more inclusive policies. Sometimes, the opportunity for advocacy starts from a tragedy.

The Orlando mass shooting in 2016 hit two communities especially hard. The shooter was Muslim and most of the victims were gay. In Dallas, this heartbreaking event brought together two leaders from the LGBTQ and Muslim communities who had never met: the Center's CEO, Cece Cox, and Executive Director for the DFW chapter of the Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR), Alia Salem. After a vigil held at the new community center, Cece and Alia joined in a press conference to condemn the horrific attack and offer condolences to the loved ones of those killed and injured. Together, they worked on ways to focus on what the LGBTQ

and Muslim communities could do to create future opportunities for shared learning and build on common bonds.

Alia says, "As simultaneously targeted communities we must first and foremost advocate for each other when tragedy strikes, and proactively face the issues that affect both communities through coalition building and grassroots mobilization.

Too often we think of issues in a vacuum, as if they are independent of one another and should only be addressed by the community affected. This way of thinking is counterproductive and short-sighted. When one community is facing a seemingly insurmountable challenge, it is incumbent upon all marginalized communities to respond meaningfully as if it was affecting them directly. This building of power and sharing of resources can create a collective impact that is exponentially more effective than acting on our own."

On June 12, 2016 just nine days after staff moved into the new community center at 5750 Cedar Springs, over a thousand people gathered at the Center to reflect and remember the 49 people killed earlier that day in a mass shooting at Pulse, an LGBTQ nightclub in Orlando. It was a Sunday, and the Center was not open, yet staff and hundreds of community members and supporters were drawn to the building as a beacon of comfort and safety. It was also a place where we poured out our anger, shock, grief, and ultimately, our love as we were able to gather together for a vigil that evening. Attendees heard from a variety of community, faith and political leaders including Center CEO Cece Cox. Earlier that day, the Center hosted a news conference featuring a variety of interfaith leaders including a rabbi and an imam decrying the shooting and calling for communities to rally together. After the speeches, most of the attandees walked over a mile from the Center to the Legacy of Love monument, turning it into a public shrine of mourning for the murdered. Throughout its 34-plus year history, the Center has served as a place for LGBTQ people and their allies to gather together in both the good and bad times, in celebration and mourning.

"I didn't choose to volunteer at the United Black Ellument (UBE) Mpowerment Project; it was fate that brought us together. I knew that I wanted to do volunteer work in the Black community of Dallas, my community. One day as I was going through some old emails I came across one that looked like an invitation. I remember thinking how random it was that junk mail was in my inbox. When I clicked on it, I was surprised to find a picture of a shirtless guy and talk about same-gender loving men. As I read the email, I became curious about who these guys were and what this UBE Mpowerment Project was about.


At the time I was out to my family, but not to the public, so when I arrived at UBE and this cute guy with dreaded hair greeted me, I realized this was my first time meeting a gay, Black and out male my own age. As soon as he was done showing me around and I agreed to volunteer, another guy came up and starting hugging me for dear life. For those

who know me, I hate hugs from people I don't know. But for some reason, I didn't push him away. When he pulled back,

he said, "Welcome to UBE."

This group of young men choose to stand together on good days, bad days and the indifferent ones; and not because they have to but because they want to.

The best part of volunteering at UBE is the brotherhood! It is incredible knowing that outside of my family and friends, there is a brotherhood of guys like me who are going through the same life struggles. It's almost like true unconditional love."

GIVE

"My son, Clyde Parker (he preferred "Parker"), passed away from suicide this year at the age of 22. Parker always had a difficult time accepting and loving himself as a transgender person. He hated being what he considered "different." No matter his troubles, Parker had a big heart for others, especially his family, close friends, and animals. He tried to act like he didn't care about things to keep people at a distance, but for those close to him, he wore his heart on his sleeve. He was the best kid I could have ever hoped for, despite his struggles.

Although Parker had been presenting himself as a male since he was three years old, he knew no other transgender kids by the time he was 14. I looked online for a transgender support group and found Youth First! I remember that first night after Parker attended Youth First's Gender Identity Night, he had a huge smile on his face that I had not seen in some time. He was so excited to learn that he was not alone and what he



was experiencing was normal. He was also proud that the group couldn't tell from his appearance which way he was transitioning — they thought he could either be male to female or vice versa, which made him feel even more manly.

That first night at Youth First, I learned that a lot of kids like Parker have parents who turn their backs and will not support them on this journey. I also learned that many of these kids have no place to live or sleep, no way to get food, clothing or medical services, or even a way to get to school! But at Youth

First, I met people who care deeply about these children and discovered a program that works to connect them to the services they need while providing a safe and accepting environment for those with nowhere else to turn.

When Parker passed away, I remembered how Youth First had given him hope and about the kids who don't have the support of family and friends like he did.



I wanted to help those kids, so in lieu of flowers, I asked people to donate to Youth First. I was surprised by the number of donations made to Youth First, and it gave me comfort to know that Parker is making a difference in other people's lives here on earth."

Of the nearly 200 youth that participate in Youth First programming,

- 25% identify as transgender male
- 10% identify as transgender female
- 9% identify as gender non-conforming

Youth First hosts a weekly Gender Identity group for transgender and gender non-conforming youth. This is one of the program's most popular events.

In 2015, the Center broke ground to begin construction on the 20,000 square foot new community center located near the intersection of Cedar springs and Inwood roads. A part of an \$8.7 million capital campaign, the new community center houses LGBTQ-focused programs for youth, families, seniors and behavioral health programs.







3 facilities were consolidated to include HIV services, nutrition services and the food pantry Located at 2701 Reagan St. in the heart of Oak Lawn, the health campus lies in the historic center of Dallas' lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and queer/questioning (LGBTQ) community. As part of the capital campaign, the space has been remodeled to consolidate HIV services, nutrition services and the food pantry in a location that is both familiar to clients and historically significant to the North Texas LGBTQ community. This includes the John Thomas building, named in memory of the Center's first executive director and longtime community activist. The John Thomas building provides HIV case management, insurance assistance, a cyber center, nutrition services and food pantry, while the second building contains a hot meals program.


